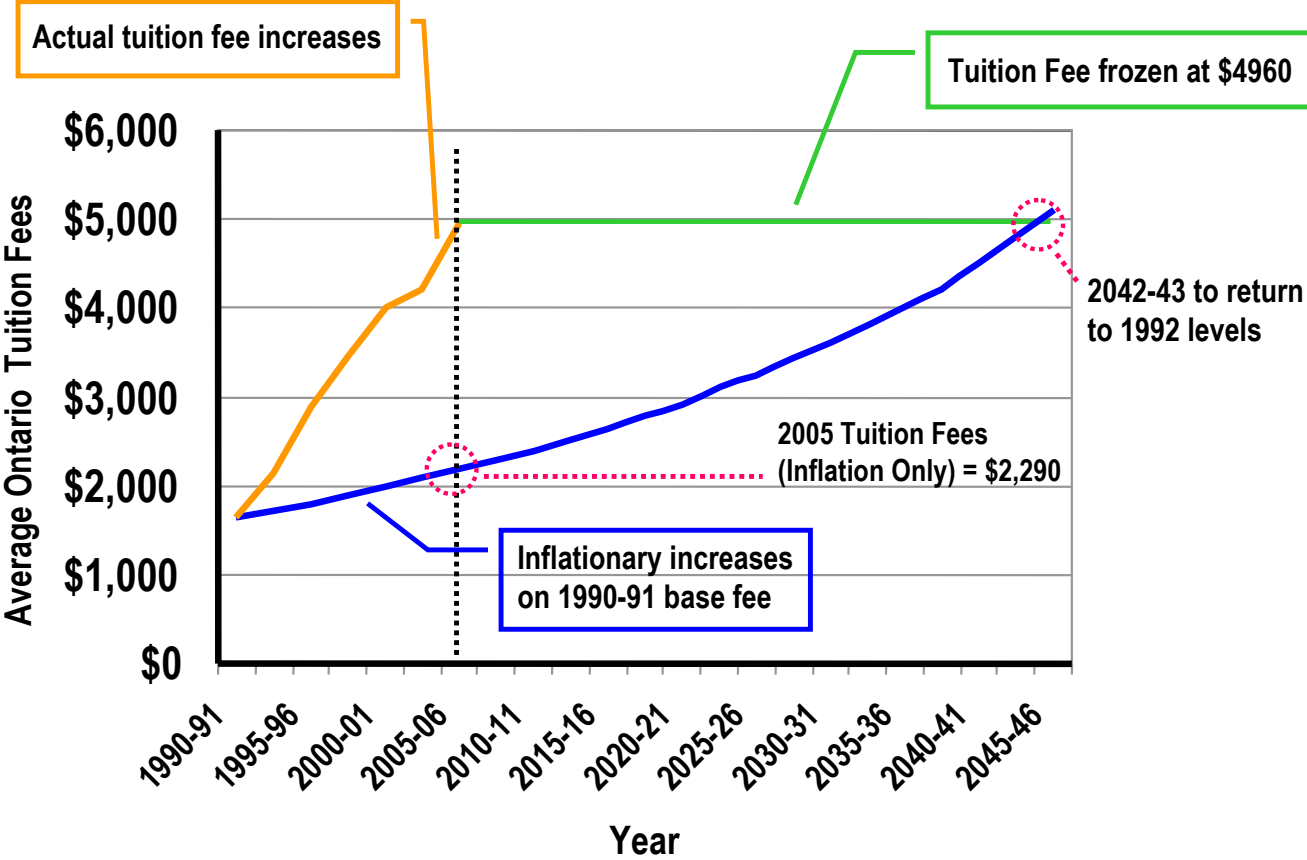

Graph: Tuition Fees versus Inflation

Tuition fee increases versus inflation (1990-91 to 2004 tuition fee freeze)



Tuition fees have increased four times faster than inflation, over the past 15 years. If fees had only increased by inflation during this period, current fees would be under \$2,300.

With the cancellation of the freeze, current tuition fees are over \$5,000. If tuition fees were immediately rolled back to 2004 levels, it would still take 40 years for inflation to catch up with Ontario tuition fees.
